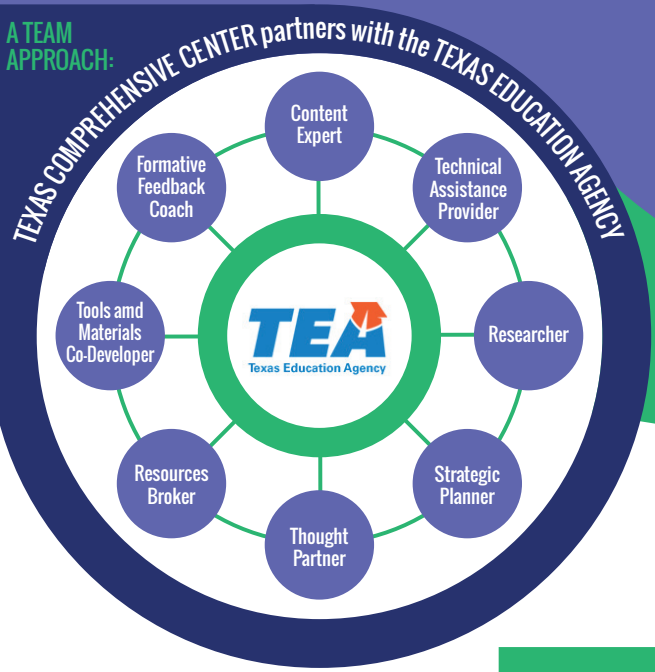


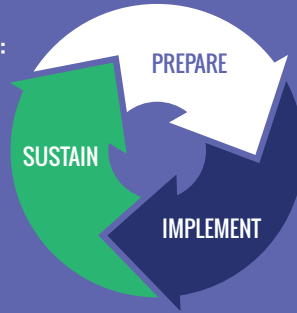
THE TEXAS COMPREHENSIVE CENTER
